APPEARANCE

- *Keep hair properly groomed

ATTENDANCE

GUIDANCE

- *In a non-emergency, students need a pass to see a counselor. Request an appointment through e-mail or a note in mailbox

- *Transcript request forms must be signed by a parent and given to your counselor
- *Transcripts require a minimum of two (2) school days to process

TARDY POLICY
